The \$17 million project included a renovation of corporate offices, an addition of 150,000 sq. ft. to the existing 200,000 square foot distribution facility, and the retention of 177 and creation of 15 jobs. The new warehouse space includes new racking and shelving and a conveyor system that moves product to and from a 50,000 sq. ft. mezzanine above the shipping area.

A leading farm and ranch supplier throughout the Upper Midwest, Bomgaars was established in Sioux City in 1952 and remains a family-owned company. Recent expansion in to Western states such as Colorado, Wyoming, and Idaho has grown the company a total of 77 stores and more than 2,000 employees company-wide. The new distribution facility will allow the company to more efficiently handle these new stores and allow for the company's future predicted growth.
